

**Spokane Regional Emergency Communications
Resolution No. 2022-01**

A Resolution of the Governing Board of the Spokane Regional Emergency Communications to designate funds from the 2021 Ending Cash & Investments as Capital Project Reserves effective 12/31/2021.

WHEREAS, Spokane Regional Emergency Communications (“SREC”) is a municipal corporation operating and existing under and pursuant to the Constitution and the laws of the state of Washington, pursuant to RCW 35.21.730 through RCW 35.21.759 and under the direction of its Governing Board (the “Board”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the by-laws the Board is empowered and authorized to approve the annual budget, capital improvement plan, and long-term funding methodologies based on the recommendation of the Executive Director and the Financial Sub-committee.

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the recommended designation of \$14,000,000 as Committed to Capital Project #2-Facility Replacement Reserve:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board as follows:

1. The Board hereby approves the designation of funds to the Capital Project #2-Facility Replacement Reserve.
